By reference to the latter, it will be seen that in the district between Prescott and Kingston, a narrow belt of this formation crosses the St. Lawrence, and expands over a large extent of country, comprising the Adirondack region, in the State of New York. This belt forms a somewhat important feature in the geology of Western Canada. It will be alluded to again, in connection with this sketch, under the name of the gneissoid belt of the Upper St. Lawrence. The Huronian Formation which constitutes the higher division of the Azoic series, consists chiefly of green and greyish slate-conglomerates and other partially altered strata, interstratified with greenstone masses,...
